

PBC UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

The Parents and Citizens' Association is strongly supportive of the wearing of full and correct school uniform and have requested the school to ensure that it is worn. PBC is a uniform school and all parents and students enrolling here are expected to accept this and wear the correct uniform. This is also part of our school security program.

Incorrectly dressed students may be required by school staff to change into uniform or an appropriate consequence may be given by a Deputy Principal.

FORMAL UNIFORM (male)

Shirt	Short sleeved, blue stripes with PBC trim on sleeve
Shorts	Navy, King Gee polyester with side tabs
Track Suit Top	Navy Blue with school logo
Track Suit Pants	Navy Blue
Shoes	Enclosed laced-up joggers predominately black or white

FORMAL UNIFORM (female)

Shirt	Senior - white with red/blue trim Junior - red, white blue check
Skirt	Navy, pleated, zip pocket no shorter than mid-thigh
Shorts	PBC tailored shorts
Track Suit	Top: Navy Blue with school logo Pants: Navy Blue
Shoes	Enclosed laced-up joggers predominately black or white
Stockings	Skin coloured only

SPORTS UNIFORM (male)

Shirt	White polo shirt with school logo, collar, button front
Shorts	Red, longer-leg, elastic waist with drawstring
Shoes	Enclosed laced-up joggers predominately black or white

SPORTS UNIFORM (female)

Shirt	White polo shirt with school logo, collar, button front
Skirt	Red pleated netball skirt
Shorts	Red, elastic waist rugby fabric
Bike Pants	Red with white side inserts
Shoes	Enclosed laced-up joggers predominately black or white

Garments other than those listed above should not be worn in any way as part of the school uniform. Garments not purchased at the uniform shop may be unsuitable for school. T Shirts worn under a school shirt or blouse should not be visible in any way.

CHANGING FOR ACTIVITIES

The formal day uniform is to be at school and worn to and from school each day except when sports uniform may be worn. When it is necessary to change for activities (eg: Physical Education, Sports Excellence and Art), time is allocated in the lesson to change into special gear then back into uniform.

EXCURSIONS

Unless advised otherwise, students wear the formal day uniform on excursions.

UNIFORM SHOP

The Uniform Shop is open every day from 8.30am to 10.30am. You can purchase here all your uniform requirements at competitive prices. As well, a range of second hand uniforms in good condition is available at considerable savings. All profits are used by the P & C for facilities to benefit the students.

JEWELLERY & MAKE UP

Excessive jewellery and makeup are inappropriate for school wear. A watch, one chain/necklace and one ring may be worn as well as one small earring or stud in each ear. **Other forms of facial or other visible jewellery/piercing are not acceptable. Students wearing excessive make up, jewellery or piercing may be required by school staff to remove these items.**
